The school celebrated Krishna Janmastami on 20th August 2022

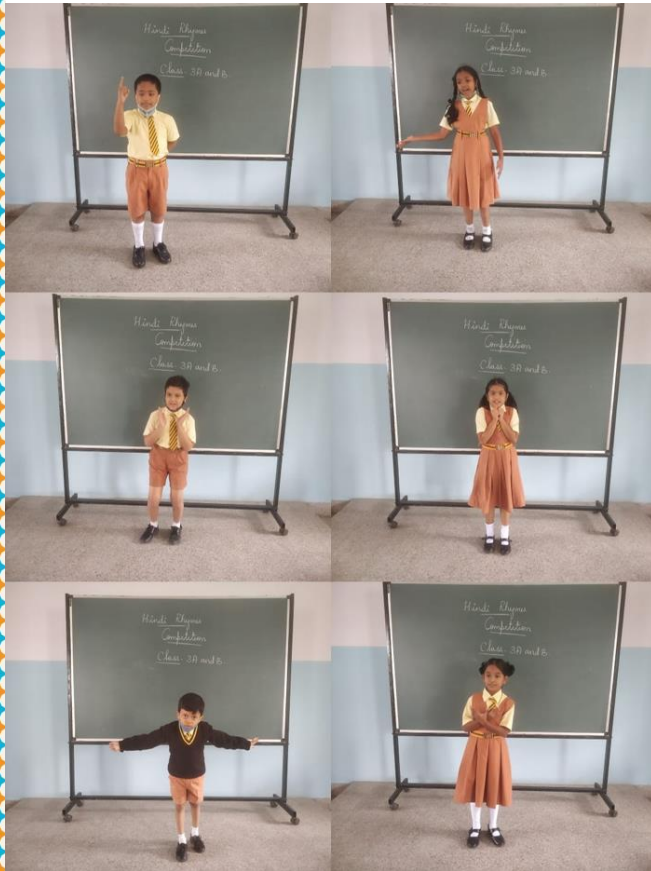
